Tasting Notes:

Pale brilliant ruby red in color. Flavors of raspberries, currant jam and balsamic and the aging in barrels brings a touch of caramel. Elegant and balanced with smooth and velvety tannins and intense red fruits.

Winemaker: Mauricio Lorca

Mauricio Lorca was born in Rivadavia, Mendoza and studied enology. At the age of 21, he began his professional life in Catena Zapata, two years later he joined Michel Torino in Cafayate, Salta; at the age of 24 he returned to Mendoza to become the head winemaker of Bodega Luigi Bosca; four years later he assumed head winemaker at Finca La Celia where he achieved well-known awards.

As of 2002, he is the winemaker and general manager of Bodega Foster, and in parallel he runs and develops his personal project: Bodega y Viñedos Mauricio Lorca. He is one of the few winemakers in Argentina distinguished by the American wine critic Robert Parker with a high score of 96 points.
